Ionising Radiation Regulations 2017

Information

The Swansea Council, Local Education Authority (LEA) is committed to providing a safe working and learning environment for staff and pupils alike. The new Ionising Radiation Regulations 2017 (IRR17) came into force in January 2018 and will replace the existing regulations (IRR99).

Many schools within the control of the LEA possess and use sources of radiation as part of the science curriculum and as such are a valuable tool to assist in the learning processes for pupils.

There is a legal obligation under the terms of the (IRR17) for all schools that use sources of radiation to register with CLEAPSS in order to ensure that best practice is being maintained whilst sources of radiation are being used.

There is a fee for registration to CLEAPSS for this service; this is a one off payment of £25.00 per school. There is also a deadline for registration, which must be completed by 4th February 2018. The following link will direct you to the webpage for registrations: www.cleapss.org.uk
