Information: AED - Telefunken Models HR1 & FA1 Defibrillators

The Medicines & Healthcare Products Regulatory Agency (MHRA) recently sent out a Safety Alert regarding **Telefunken** automatic external defibrillators (AED), pads and batteries.

MHRA states that these defibrillators, pads and batteries (Manufactured by Defiteq International BV or GGT Holding BV) are no longer certified for use in the UK and therefore the safety and performance of these devices cannot be verified and their safe use can no longer be assured.

Action to be taken

Heads of Service - Please cascaded this safety notice down to all managers within your area of responsibility to make.

Managers/Head teachers – if your premises has an AED, check the make and model. If you have a Telefunken HR1 & FA1 defibrillator do not use it as these devices do not meeting regulatory requirements for safety and performance. You will need to replace it with an alternative make/model AED.
