NOTICE is hereby given that an application has been made by Carol Williams and Sue James to the Council of the City and County of Swansea as Commons Registration Authority, concerning park land situated at Brynawel Road and Princess Street, Gorseinon SA4 4UX and known as Parc Y Werin.

The Applicants assert that the land edged in red on the plan annexed to the application formed part of an area of land referred to as Loughor Common on two maps from the 19th Century.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by adding the land to the register of common land.




