

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SWANSEA (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (which said Act of 1984 is hereby referred to as "the Act of 1984") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III Schedule 9 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order:

SECTION 1 – PRELIMINARY

Citation and commencement

THIS Order shall come into operation on the 21st day of July 2021 and may be cited as "the Council of the City and County of Swansea (Experimental Order) Temporary Additional Permit Holder Bays Jones Terrace (Part), City Centre, Swansea, Order 2021". The restrictions of this Order will continue in force until Friday 20th January 2023.

Definitions

2. In this order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

"Civil Enforcement Officer" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Act of 1984 and by virtue of Section 76 of the 2004 Act a Civil Enforcement Officer appointed under Section 63A of the Act of 1984 is a Civil Enforcement Officer in relation to parking contraventions;

"Relevant Position" in respect of:-

- (a) a permit means exhibited on the windscreen, dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the permit is clearly legible from outside the vehicle:
- (b) a Waiver means exhibited on the windscreen, dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole of the information on the front of the waiver is clearly legible from outside the vehicle:

"Waiver" means a Waiver issued by the Council in respect of vehicles being used for building maintenance repair shop fitting or other industrial or demolition operations and the Council may charge for such Waiver such charge to be determined from time to time by resolution of the Council or relevant Committee thereof;

<u>Interpretation</u>

- 3. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order
- 4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament
- 5. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other prohibition or restriction whether made under the Act of 1984 or otherwise

SECTION 2 - ADDITIONAL PERMIT HOLDER BAYS

6. Save as provided in Articles 7 and 8 no person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a Civil Enforcement Officer, police community support officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle to wait on any of the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in Schedule 1 hereto.

Exemptions

- 7. Nothing in Article 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle displaying a physical permit in the Relevant Position or subject to a digital permit covering the specified area to wait on the side or sides or length or lengths of the road or roads specified in Schedule 1.
- 8. Nothing in Article 6 of this Order shall render it unlawful to cause or permit any vehicle to wait on the side or sides or length or lengths of the road or roads specified therein for as long as may be necessary to enable:
 - a) the vehicle, if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations namely:-
 - building, maintenance, repair, shop fitting or other industrial or demolition operations with a Waiver issued by the Council and displayed in the relevant position on the windscreen of the vehicle;
 - ii. the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - iii. the laying, erection, alteration or repair in or on land adjacent to the said lengths or sides of the road of any sewer or any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of water, gas electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined by the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - iv. a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire brigade or other emergency purposes;

- b) the vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with the service of a local authority or of a water authority in pursuance of its statutory powers and duties;
- c) the vehicle of the Royal Mail or other universal services provider as defined in Section 4 of the Postal Services Act 2000 to be used for the purpose of delivering or collecting mail;
- d) vehicles picking up and dropping off passengers
