**NOTICE** is hereby given that the Council of the City and County of Swansea in pursuance of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) has made an Order. In order for Wales and West Utilities to carry out gas mains replacement at the above location, it has been necessary to temporarily close the above road to vehicular traffic.

**SCHEDULE - TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE  
NORTON AVENUE, MUMBLES (PART)**

Norton Avenue in a westerly direction from its junction with Mumbles Road, a distance of approximately 40 metres.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via Mumbles Road, Norton Road, Westcross Avenue, and Norton Avenue, a distance of approximately 600 metres.

Similarly, this route will operate in the reverse direction.

**Access for emergency vehicles, pedestrians and residents to be maintained at all times.**

The maximum duration of the order is 18 months and it is anticipated the work will take 12 days to complete effective from **17<sup>th</sup> June 2024**.

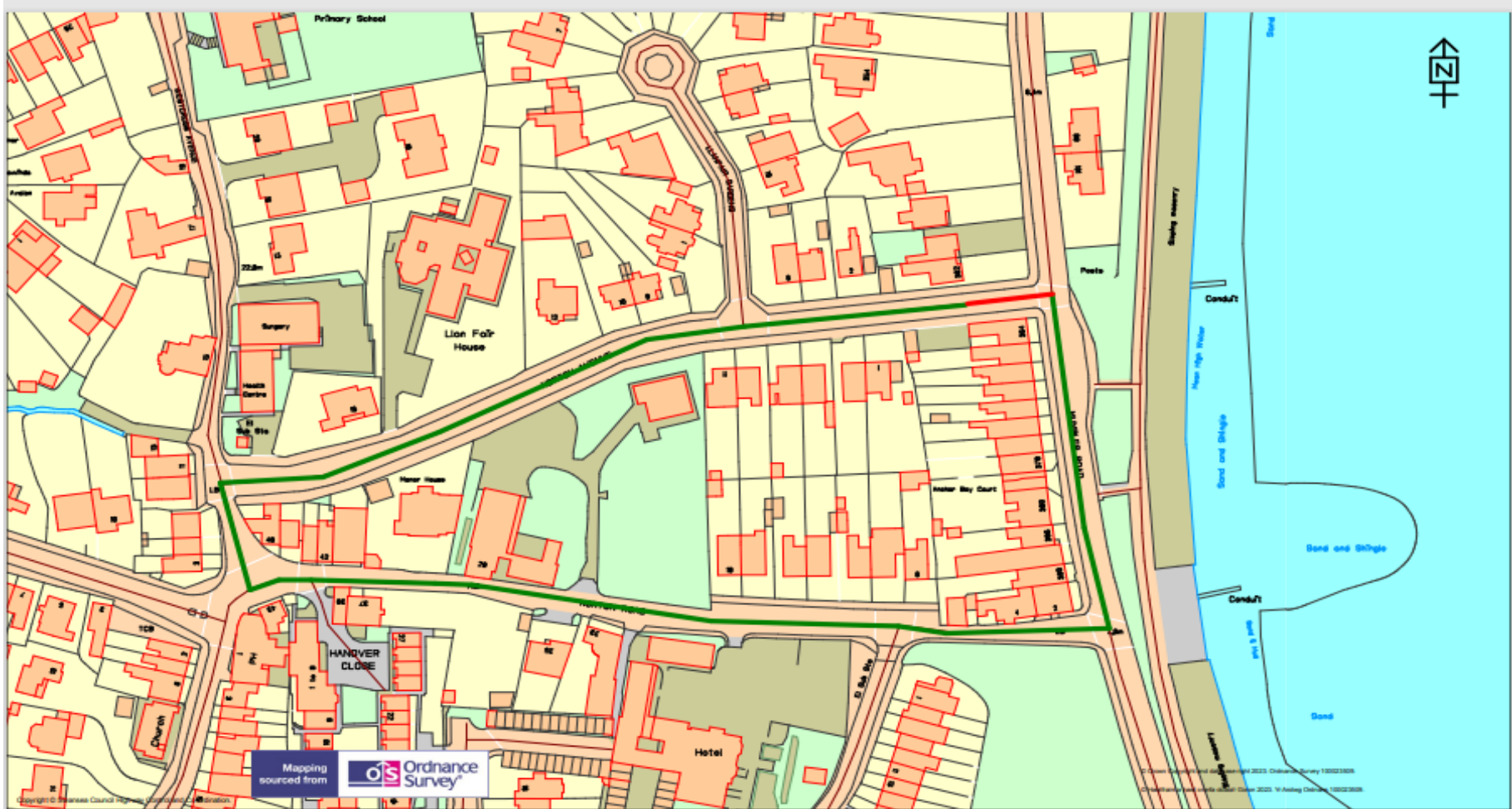
