Civilian War Dead and Injured

Use the lists of Civilian Deaths and Casualties to do the following:

- Work out how many people were killed and injured
- Who was the youngest and oldest person to die?
- What else can you find out about the youngest person to die? **Hint can you find anyone with the same surname on the list of Casualties?**
- Look at the Index of Civilian Deaths. Where were the dead taken before burial? Why do you think they were taken there?
