

Rhossili Cliffs Walk

Rhossili is the most Western point of the Gower Peninsula and a village steeped in history dating as far back as the Bronze Age. The walk allows you to experience why Rhossili is widely regarded as the most picturesque and photographed part of the Gower, with breathtaking views of Rhossili Bay and the iconic landmark Worms Head.

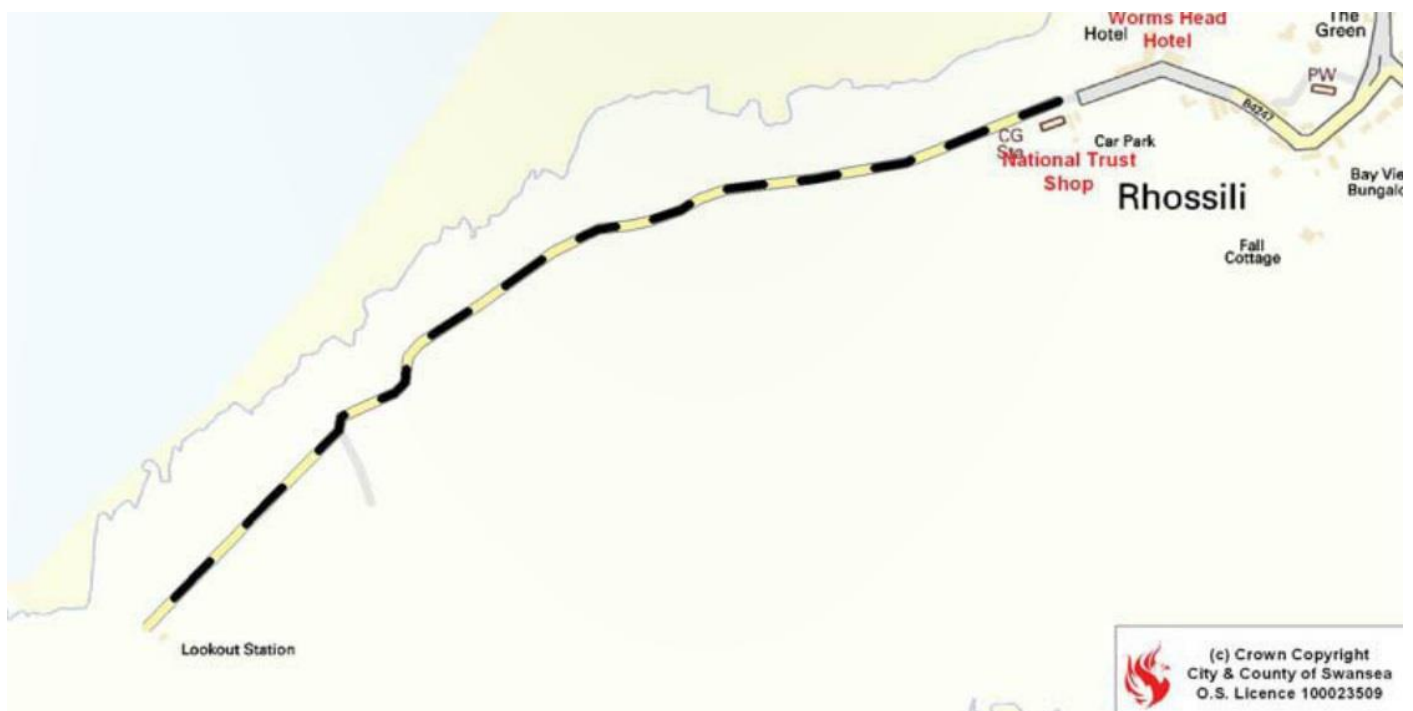
- Grade 2: Moderate
- Distance: 1.6 miles
- Parking
- Café amenities nearby

Directions

- Start at Rhossili Car Park. Please note there is a cost for parking during the summer months
- Head to the bottom corner of the car park by the toilet block then access the path, which heads past the National Trust Shop and Cottages, until you reach a gate. At this point please read all the safety signs before continuing.
- Once past the gate keep to the gravel path and continue heading to the small building which is known as the Outer Lookout and is now manned by the National Coastwatch Institution
- At this point you have walked a distance of 1.3km / 0.7 miles
- Turn around and walk back in the direction you came from
- The path is reasonably flat but beware of other users along the way

Information

- The Worms Head Hotel is available for refreshments
- Benches along this route
- Toilets on this route at the bottom of the car park
- The route is not best suited for pushchairs/wheelchairs due to the gravel path

- Dechreuwch ym Maes Parcio Rhosili. Sylwer bod cost am barcio yn ystod misoedd y haf
- Ewch i gornel gwaelod y maes parcio ger y bloc toiledau yna ewch ar y llwybr, sy'n mynd heibio i Siopau a Bythynnod yr Ymddiriedolaeth Genedlaethol, tan i chi gyrraedd gât. Ar y pwynt hwn, darllenwch yr holl arwyddion diogelwch cyn parhau
- Pan fyddwch wedi pasio'r glwyd, cadwch ar y llwybr graean ac ewch ymlaen tua'r adeilad bach o'r enw'r 'Outer Lookout', sydd bellach yn cael ei warchod gan Sefydliad Gwyllo'r Glannau Cenedlaethol
- Ar y pwynt hwn byddwch wedi cerdded am 1.3km / 0.7 milltir
- Bryd hynny, trowch o gwmpas a cherddwch yn ôl i'r cyfeiriad y daethoch ohono
- Mae'r llwybr yn gymharol wastad, ond byddwch yn ymwybodol o ddefnyddwyr eraill ar hyd y ffordd
