Part 2 East Bound :- via Oakland Road, Queens Road, Stanley Street, Newton Road, Chapel Street and Woodville Road, a distance of approximately 900 metres.

These routes are suitable for light vehicles only.


Access for emergency vehicles and pedestrians to be maintained at all times.


