NOTICE is hereby given that the Council of the City and County of Swansea in pursuance of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) intend to make an Order. In order for Knights Brown, Wales & Energy Division to undertake Coastal Protection Scheme works at the above locations it will be necessary to temporarily close the above road to vehicular traffic.

SCHEDULE – TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE
PROMENADE TERRACE, MUMBLES

Promenade Terrace in a northerly direction from its junction with Mumbles Road for a distance of approximately 60 metres.

The alternative route for vehicular traffic will be via the unaffected section of Promenade Terrace, Cornwall Place and Mumbles Road.

Similarly, this route will operate in the reverse direction and is suitable for light traffic only.

Access for emergency vehicles and residents to be maintained at all times.

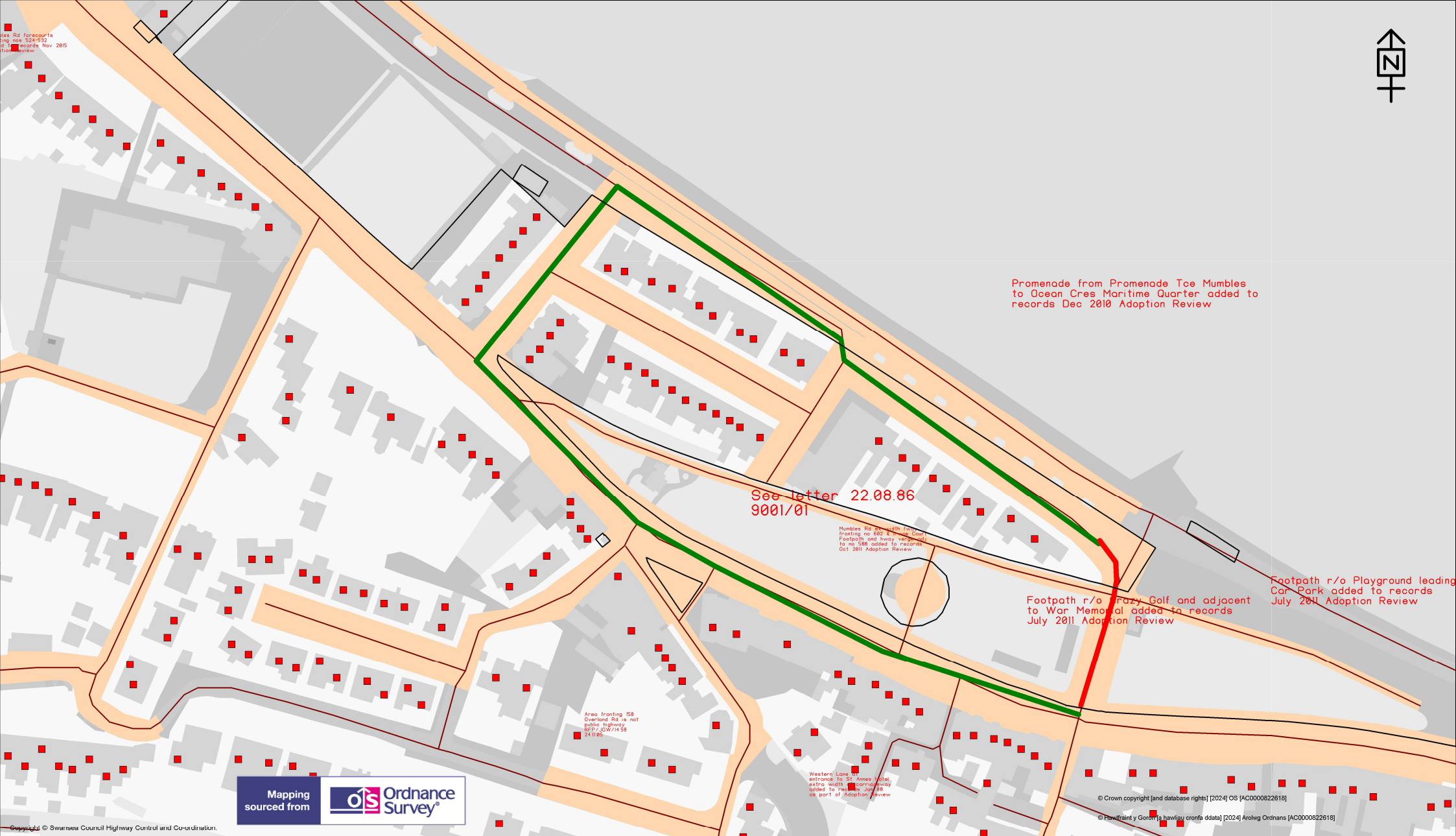
The maximum duration of the order is 18 months and it is anticipated the work will take **6 weeks** to complete effective from **Monday 23rd June 2025**.
