Byelaws made by the Council of the City and County of Swansea under section 235 of the Local Government Act 1972 for the good rule and government of the City and County of Swansea and for the prevention and suppression of nuisances.

EXTENT

1. These byelaws apply to the specified parts of the City and County of Swansea designated in the schedule to the byelaws and hereinafter referred to as the "designated areas".

SKATEBOARDING

2. No person shall in any of the designated areas skate on rollers, skateboards, wheels or other mechanical contrivances.

PENALTY

3. Any person offending against byelaw 2 shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding level 2 on the standard scale.


SCHEDULE

The "designated areas" referred to in byelaw 1 and delineated by black hatching on the plan attached to these byelaws are as follows:

1. Nelson Street - Extending east of its junction with Plymouth Street for a distance of approximately 72 metres to a point parallel with No. 17 Nelson Street.

- Union Street From a point parallel with the Quardant Gate public house extending east and then north for approximately 180 metres to the junction with Park Street at a point parallel to 17 Union Street.
- Oxford Street From a point west of (and inclusive of) 234 Oxford Street for a distance of approximately 340 metres to its junction with Princess Way.
- 4. Portland Street From a point parallel with 1 Portland Street and its junction with Park Street extending south for a distance of approximately 45 metres to its junction with Oxford Street.
- 5. Whitewalls From a point parallel with 801 Oxford Street extending south for a distance of approximately 90 metres to its junction with St. Marys Square.
- St. Mary's Square West of St. Marys Church including frontage to C and A and Whitewalls entrance to the Quadrant.
- St. Davids Square/Shopping Centre Extending south from St. Marys Square to the junction with Rutland Street and the pedestrian area to the east of Oldway House.



- Princess Way From a point parallel with 35 Princess Way extending south for a distance of 160 metres to its junction with Caer Street.
- Castle Square/Castle Bailey Street Including Temple Street and part Princess Way to its junction with Caer Street (footway and pedestrian areas).
- 10. St. Marys Street From a point parallel with 12 St. Marys Street extending east for a distance of approximately 50 metres to the junction with Wind Street.
- 11. Salubrious Place From its junction with Wind Street extending south westerly for a distance of approximately 80 metres.
- 12. Worcester Place From a point parallel with the rear of 32 Castle Street extending southwards for a distance of approximately 80 metres. Including the pedestrian footway to Parc Tawe.
- 13. Wind Street Including all footways and pedestrian areas from a point parallel with 7 Castle Square extending south for a distance of approximately 200 metres to the junction of Wind Street and Little Wind Street.
- 14. Castle Square including all footways and pedestrian areas from a point parallel to 2 Castle Square and the junction of Caer Street extending south for a distance of approximately 50 metres to a point parallel with 1 Wind Street.
