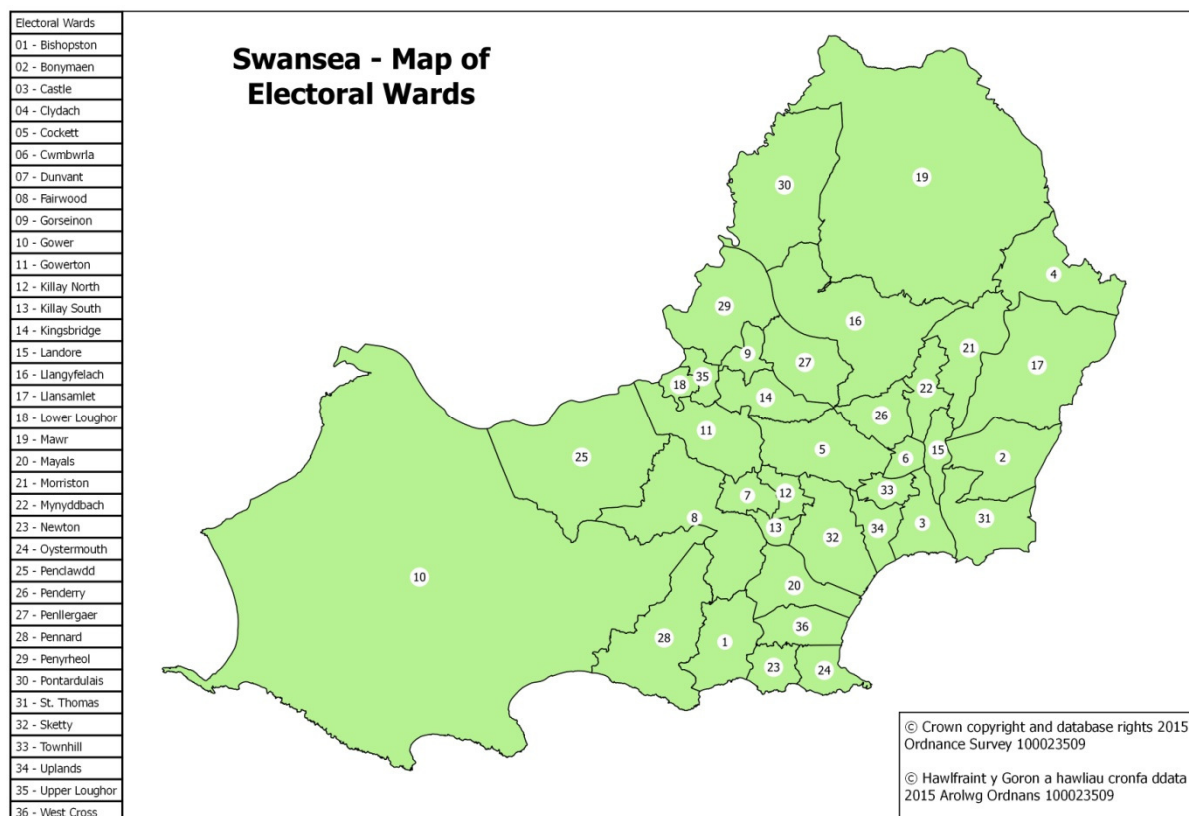


2001 CENSUS: KEY INDICATORS FOR WARDS
