#### **REVOCATIONS**

#### **SCHEDULE 2**

#### **20MPH SPEED ZONE**

**GUILDHALL ROAD SOUTH (B4290)** – from a point 35 metres south west of its junction with Francis Street for a distance of 270 metres in a north easterly direction to its junction with St Helen's Road (B4290).

**ST HELEN'S ROAD (B4290)** – from its junction with Guildhall Road South (B4290) for a distance of 738 metres in a north easterly direction.

**FRANCIS STREET –** from its junction with Guildhall Road South (B4290) north west for a distance of 25 metres.


**ST HELEN'S CRESCENT –** from its junction with St Helen's Road (B4290) north west for a distance of 22 metres.

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SWANSEA (hereinafter called "the Council") in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1984") and the Traffic Management Act 2004 and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 and Section 124 of the Act of 1984 hereby make the following Order.

#### **SECTION 1 – PRELIMINARY**

#### Citation and commencement

 This Order shall come into operation on 12<sup>th</sup> October 2021 and may be cited as the Council of the City and County of Swansea St Helen's Road and Guildhall Road South, Swansea - 20 MPH Speed Limit Traffic Regulation Order 2021

#### **Definitions**

2. In this order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meaning hereby respectively assigned to them:

"civil enforcement officer" has the same meaning as in Section 63A of the Act of 1984 and by virtue of Section 76 of the 2004 Act a civil enforcement officer appointed under Section 63A of the Act of 1984 is a civil enforcement officer in relation to parking contraventions;

"exempted vehicles" means:

- (a) any vehicles being used by the emergency services for the purposes described in section 87 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;
- (b) any vehicles being used for naval, military, or air force purposes, and being driven by a person for the time being subject to the orders of the member of the armed forces of the crown, who is a member of the special forces –

- (i) in response, or for a practice in responding, to a national security emergency by a person who has been trained in driving at high speeds, or;
- (ii) for the purpose of training a person in driving vehicles at high speeds

#### <u>Interpretation</u>

- 3. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order
- 4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the Interpretation of an Act of Parliament
- The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any other prohibition or restriction whether made under the Act of 1984 or otherwise

#### **SECTION 2 – 20MPH SPEED LIMIT**

6. Save as provided in Article 7 of this order and except on the direction or with the permission of a civil enforcement officer, police officer in uniform, or a person authorised by the Council, no person shall cause any vehicle to proceed at a speed in excess of 20 miles per hour on the length or lengths of road or roads referred to in Schedule 2 hereto.

#### **Exemptions**

7. Nothing in Article 6 shall apply to exempted vehicles.

#### **REVOCATION**

8. The existing Orders are revoked insofar as they are inconsistent with the proposals contained in the schedules hereto and insofar as they relate to the length or lengths of the road or roads referred to in the Schedules hereto.
