

Notice of confirmation of public path order Highways Act 1980 the Council of the City and County of Swansea, footpath 13 and 15, Community of Ilston, public path diversion order 2021. On 25th November 2021, the Council of the City and County of Swansea confirmed the above order made under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980. The effect of the order as confirmed is to divert the public footpath running from grid ref. SS523891 to SS522895 to a line commencing at grid ref. SS524893 to SS522895, and the public footpath running from grid ref. SS522892 to SS523892 to a line commencing at grid ref. SS523891 to SS523892 as shown on the order map. A copy of the order and the order map may be seen at all times on the notice board outside the main entrance of the offices of the Council of the City and County of Swansea, Civic Centre, Swansea SA1 3SN or a copy may be obtained free of charge at the Civic Centre reception desk between 8.30 a.m. and 4.00 p.m. Mondays to Fridays. The notice and order can also be seen at www.swansea.gov.uk/publicpathorders The order comes into force on 6th January 2022 but if a person aggrieved by the order wants to question its validity, or that of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the power of the Highways Act 1980, as amended, or on the ground that any requirement of the Act, as amended, or of any regulation made under the Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may under Paragraph 2 of Schedule 2 to the Act as applied by Paragraph 5 of Schedule 6 to the Act, within 6 weeks from 8th December 2021 make an application to the High Court. PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2021
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 SECTION 119
THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY AND COUNTY OF SWANSEA
FOOTPATHS 13 AND 15, COMMUNITY OF ILSTON

This order is made by The Council of the City and County of Swansea ("the authority") under Section 119 of the Highways Act 1980 ("the 1980 Act") because it appears to the Authority that in the interests of the owners of the land crossed by the footpaths described in paragraph I of this order it is expedient that the line of path should be diverted.

Jon Marson and Claire Marson of Longoaks Cottage have agreed to defray any compensation which becomes payable in consequence of the coming into force of this order.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the land situated at Longoaks, Penmaen and shown by a bold continuous line on the map contained in this order and described in part I of the Schedule to this order shall be stopped up after 42 days from the date of confirmation of this order.
2. There shall be at the end of 42 days from the date of confirmation of this order be a public footpath over the land situated at Longoaks, Penmaen described in Part 2 of the Schedule and shown by a broken line on the map contained in this order.
3. The rights conferred on the public under this order shall be subject to the limitations and conditions set out in Part 3 of the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

PART 1

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF EXISTING PATH OR WAY

Footpath 13. Commencing on bridleway 16 at point A and proceeding in a north westerly direction for a distance of 125 metres to point B, then continuing in a north westerly direction for 35 metres to point C, then in a north easterly direction for 20 metres to point D, then in a generally northerly direction for 70 metres to point E, then in a generally north westerly direction for 77 metres to point F, then in a north north easterly direction for 35 metres to point G, then in a northerly direction for 60 metres to point H, then in a north north easterly direction for 40 metres to point I.

Footpath 15. Commencing at point B and proceeding in a north easterly direction for 120 metres to point K.

All distances and directions being approximate.

PART 2

DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF NEW PATH OR WAY

Footpath 13. Commencing on footpath 15 at point L (Ordnance Survey grid reference SS 524893) and proceeding through a gate into a field in a north westerly direction for 95 metres to point M, then in a northerly direction for 45 metres to point N, then in a north westerly direction for 70 metres to a gate at point O, continuing in a north westerly direction for 80 metres to join the rest of footpath 13 at point I (Ordnance Survey grid reference SS 522895).

Footpath 15. Commencing on bridleway 16 at point S (Ordnance Survey grid reference SS 523891) and proceeding through a gate into the woodland in a north easterly direction for 9 metres, then in a north north westerly direction for 94 metres to point Q, then in a generally north easterly direction for 100 metres to point P, then in a north north westerly direction for 30 metres to join the rest of footpath 15 at point K (Ordnance Survey grid reference SS 523892).

All distances and directions being approximate.

PART 3

LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS

Footpath 15 will be subject to a gate at point R and footpath 13 will be subject to gates at points L and O. The gates will be to British Standard BS5709:2018.


